

The reduction of transit dues of  
feeder vessels operating between Egyptian ports

**Article one**

- Feeder vessels of up to 5000 SCNT, working between Egyptian Red Sea and Mediterranean Sea ports, are to be granted a reduction 30% of the Suez Canal transit dues on the following conditions:

1- The reduction applies only to coastal vessels transporting containers between Egyptian ports.

2- The entire load of the vessel consists in Egyptian imports

-Clients who wish to make use of the said reduction have to present a prior request, stating the name of the company and the expected number of vessels with relevant full details:

-The transit dues shall be collected in full upon transit, and the reduction shall be granted once the following documents are provided:

1- A stamped certificate from the port of origin indicating the number of containers the vessel carries (full/empty), and the final destination.

2- A stamped certificate from the port of destination, indicating the number of the containers the vessel unloads (full/empty).

**Article two**

This circular takes effect as of July 1, 2010 and stays applicable for an experimental period of six months.
