

Concerning VLCC (of more than 250,000 DWT) coming from Arabian Gulf, heading to American Gulf or the Carribean zone on their round trip to transit the Suez Canal after discharging part of their cargo in SUMED line .

The Suez Canal Authority has decided the following :-

Article one:-

Any VLCC coming from south is to pay a lumpsum of USD 155,000 (including charges of tugs, charges for arrival after limit time and charges for booking in the convoy).

Article Two:-

A VLCC is to pay a lumpsum of USD 230,000 on her return ballast trip (including charges of tugs, charges for arrival after limit time and charges for booking in the convoy) .

Article Three:-

Any company wishing to benefit from this circular has to submit a request before transit through its Maritime Agency as per the attached form and conditions stated there in .

Article Four:-

This circular takes effect as of 16 June 2016 for an experimental period of 6 months (180 days), to be renewed .
